 - supports numerous MCW faculty in community engaged research projects that address a wide range of health-related topics

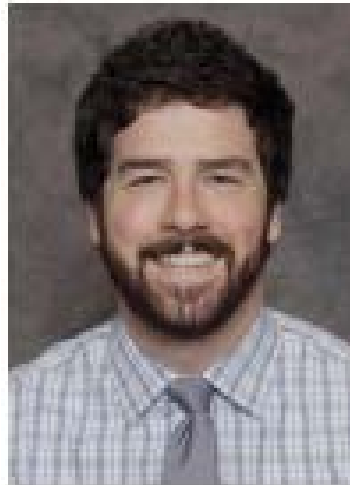


Notable Accomplishments
