## **PSAP Script**

1. Is the patient awake?

Yes: Respond as usual (see appropriate chief complaint)

No: Go to Step 2

Unsure: Try to wake them up while I wait on the line

2. Is the patient breathing normally?

Unknown: Go to Step 3

Yes: Respond as usual (see appropriate chief complaint)

No: Dispatch ALS/BLS; Transfer to MC EMS Communicator; Go to Step 4

- 3. Describe the patient's breathing, what does their breathing sound like? How often do you see them breath?
  - If breathing is absent or reported as one of the following agonal descriptors:
    - Gasping
    - Once in a while
    - Snoring now and then
    - Gurgling
    - Barely breathing
    - Moaning weak or heavy
    - Occasional

Dispatch ALS/BLS; Transfer to MC EMS Communicator

- If breathing normally: respond as usual (see appropriate chief complaint)
- 4. Transferring to MC EMS Communicator, state the following:

OK, Sir/Ma'am I am sending an ambulance now. I am also transferring you to my partner who will give you more directions...

Once the MC EMS Communicator answers state:

This \_\_\_\_\_\_ dispatch center. I have a caller reporting an \_\_\_\_\_(age if known) PNB (give an pertinent details e.g., post drowning). Unit\_\_\_\_ has been dispatched.

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<sup>\*\*\*</sup>Remain on the line until you hear MC EMS Communicator start talking to the caller\*\*\*
