

2024 Visiting Student Health Equity Program - Clinical Rotation Award



This program offers mentoring, networking, and stipend support to fourth-year visiting medical students at the Medical College of Wisconsin. Students will:

- *Connect with MCW faculty, students, and trainees*
- *Have opportunities for mentoring and advising from URIM faculty and trainees*
- *Participate in social engagement through activities showcasing the city of Milwaukee*
- *Engage in cultural inclusion and professional identity development opportunities*

Accepted students will receive a stipend of up to \$2,500 to cover application costs, housing, travel, transportation, and other living expenses.

Available Rotations

4-week rotations are available in the following departments:

Anesthesiology, Dermatology, Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, Neurology, Neurosurgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Orthopaedic Surgery, Otolaryngology, Pathology & Laboratory Medicine, Pediatrics, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Plastic Surgery, Psychiatry and Behavioral Medicine, Radiology, Radiation Oncology, Surgery, and Urology.

All visiting rotations take place in in the fall (July-December) and are subject to availability.

Specific rotation dates can be found in your VSLO (Visiting Students Learning Opportunities) application.

Program Eligibility

Accepted students must:

- Be full-time senior medical students attending an LCME-accredited medical school or COCA-accredited osteopathic medical school, in good standing at their home institution.
- Have demonstrated record of academic excellence
- Be from or have lived experience engaging people in under-served communities in the United States.
