Hosted 547 events and 1,395 event hours

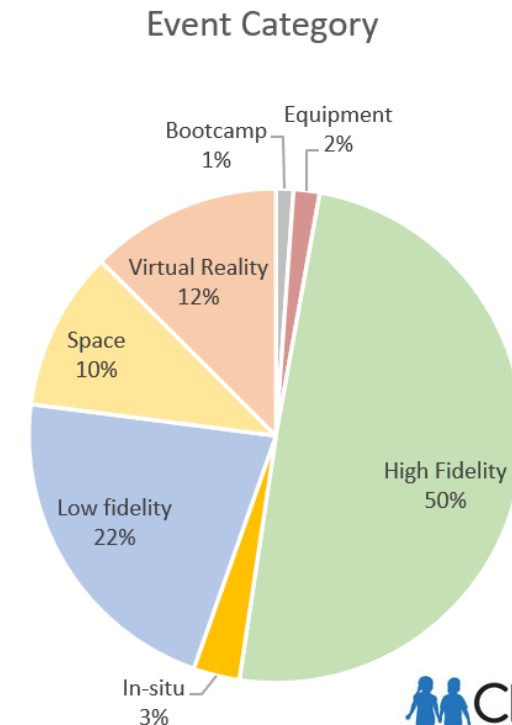
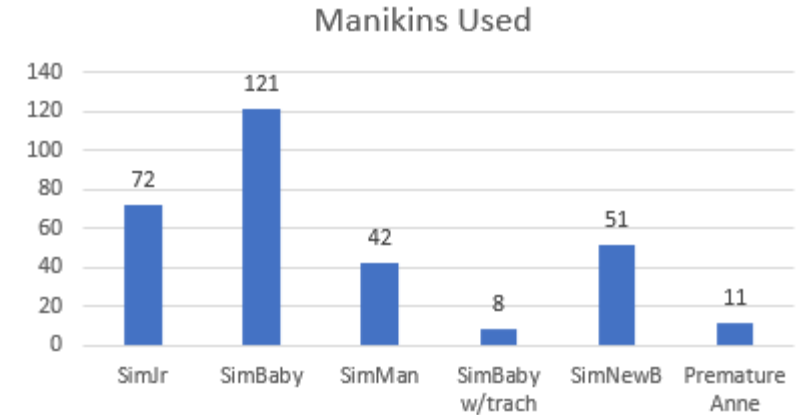
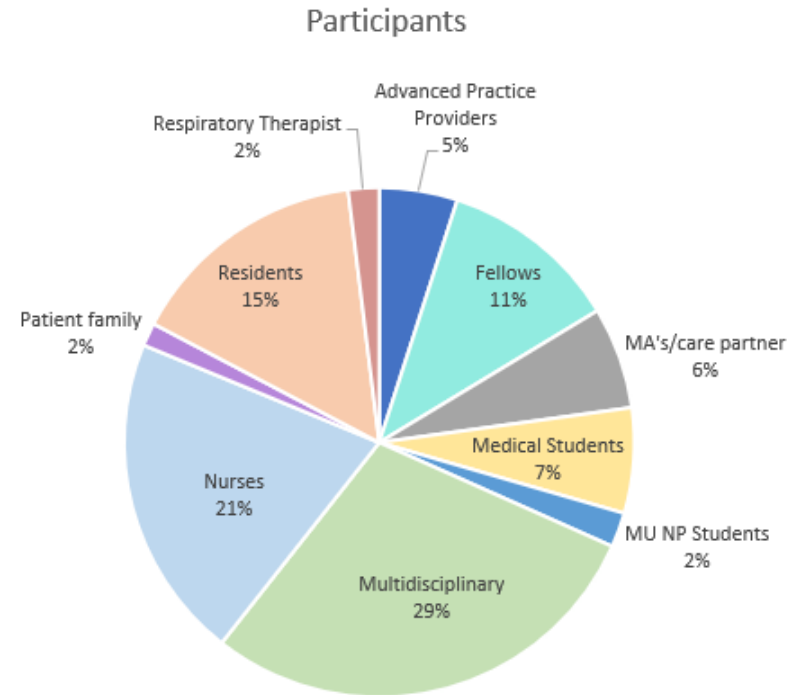


Reached 13 states

Key:

- Boot camps are intensive 4+ hour events that expose learners to various skills needed to lead and manage rare patient scenarios.
- High Fidelity events use highly realistic manikins i.e., SimBaby, SimMan3G
- Low-Fidelity/task trainer events use task trainers, skills stations, and/or role play.
- *Multidisciplinary participants include a variety of roles such as RN's, RT's, Fellows, NP's, Physicians, PA's, pharmacists, and techs
- "Other" participants include events that did not indicate the type of participants attending
