## **Starting the Application process:**

If you are an incoming/new student, the process begins by completing the Certification of Finance. This form is required and needs to be approved by the Financial Aid Office by May 1<sup>st</sup>. This form requires creation of a Dynamic Forms account before it can be completed. For instructions on how to create a Dynamic Forms account, click here.

One option to pay for school would be a Private Educational loan. You will need to find a lender for DACA students, most of whom require a credit worthy co-signer. You are free to use any lender of your choice. Do your research to make sure they are reputable and have repayment options that will work for your situation.
