To Find a Doctor or Facility

Go To www.wpsic.com and click “Find A Doctor”.

If you have your WPS Member # (example: 000123456 - from your WPS card):

1. Use “Current Members”
2. Enter your Member #, Group # (964160) and Division # (00001)
3. Click “continue” and Start your Provider Search

If you do not have your WPS Member # available:

1. Use “My Employer is Considering WPS”
2. Select “Statewide w/First Health & Beech Street” from the “select a network” list
3. Click “continue” and Start your Provider Search
