Behind the Scenes

- 2,965 print journal issues checked in
- 16 new journal titles selected by the Library Committee for the 2008 year
- 33,572 items shelved
- 17 staff members participated in 27 CE/Professional Development events
- 12,942 links/URLs provided/maintained in PubMed (1,883), Ovid (5,116), e-Journal list (3,198) and the online catalog (2,745)
- 17,359 Interlibrary Loans processed (8,822 borrows; 8,537 loans)
- 700 titles updated in ejournal knowledgebase

Selected Highlights

- Conducted 23 classes around Milwaukee teaching community members to find accurate health information online
- Carried out a National Library of Medicine Outreach Grant with a community partner to

provide training, equipment, MCW Library resources, and support to facilitate the development of a health education clinic

- Implemented a 2nd remote access authentication method using the Library's Integrated Library System allowing CHW and Froedtert staff remote access
- Finished collection development projects in electrocardiography, parasitology, and statistical genetics
- Added 6 electronic databases to the e-collection: *Access Surgery; First Consult; PsycARTICLES; Scopus; The Senses; and USP-NF Online*
- Evaluated licensed databases using a feedback survey on ANGEL for input from the MCW Community. Results assist the library in collection decisions
- Sponsored a two-day NCBI Field Guide genetics database course. Day one was a 3-hour lecture attended by 94 people from MCW, FH, CHW, and the Blood Research Institute. 53 researchers attended day two, an optional 2-hour, hands-on workshop
- Established a new service and educational offerings to assist MCW authors comply with the NIH Public Access Policy
- Partnered with Public Affairs to launch new designs for InfoScope (MCW's Intranet) and the MCW Public Web Site
- Invented, assembled and deployed new privacy filter system to support secure testing in the ICL
- Taught 6 classes in June to M-3 students highlighting PDA resources available through the Library
- Worked with research staff at the Zablocki VA to implement training certification in ANGEL that retired a largely paper process for tracking mandated certification tests
- Library Resource of the Month promotions included: Anatomy.tv, OvidSP, PubMed LinkOut, Books@Ovid, Clinical Resources page, Safari Books Online, and PDA Information page
