## CALL FOR POSTER ABSTRACTS

Centers from across the Medical College of Wisconsin are jointly hosting the **third annual State of the Science in Health Disparities conference** on October 19-20, 2023, with the theme Structural Inequality & Health Outcomes. The conference will bring together researchers, policy makers, health professionals, community organizations, and trainees to advance efforts locally, regionally, nationally, and internationally to eliminate health disparities perpetuated by structural factors. The two-day event will include morning and afternoon sessions that include nationally recognized experts across multiple disciplines and panel sessions discussing how to move forward based on current evidence. The event will also host an **evening poster session** on the first day focused on sharing work conducted by trainees and offering time for networking and career development.

Trainees engaged in research focused on reducing and eliminating health disparities are invited to submit abstracts for poster presentation at this conference in any of the topic areas below:

- Burden of structural inequalities across diverse disease groups
- Mechanisms and potential pathways linking structural inequality to health outcomes
- Interventions aimed to address structural inequalities across various disease groups
- Policy efforts and policy strategies to address structural inequalities

The Poster Session is scheduled on **October 19, 2023 from 5:00 – 6:30 pm**. This session will immediately follow the morning and afternoon conference sessions and will occur in the same location: Sonesta Milwaukee Wauwatosa. Poster boards will be provided to display posters accompanied by the author or coauthors. The Medical College of Wisconsin Library and Center for Advancing Population Science will be available to print posters.

Please use the [online submission form](#) to submit your abstract. There is a combined 350-word limit for the abstract fields. That is, the total length of the abstract (Objectives + Methods + Results + Conclusions + Impact) should not exceed 350 words. We encourage submissions from trainees at MCW and affiliate academic institutions as well as community partner organizations engaged in health disparities work.
