ABOUT THIS RESEARCH

This study is looking at the link between one's neighborhood and CKM syndrome – or heart and kidney disease – in Milwaukee. Additionally, it will assess how social determinants influence risk factors and healthcare access for Milwaukee adults with CKM syndrome.

During this visit, you will complete a questionnaire about your health, environment, and self-care, provide a small blood sample, and have your height, weight, and blood pressure measured. All participants will receive compensation for completing the visit.
