
Wisconsin OVERDOSE FATALITY REVIEWS

Depending on the number of overdose deaths in a year, some OFR sites review a portion, but not all of the deaths from overdose. <u>The figures presented here do NOT represent a random sample of overdose deaths in Wisconsin, and are not representative of all overdose deaths.</u>



The substances detected during toxicology screening are not necessarily the same as the substances determined to be the cause of death.




