Uninsured Resources

Local Options

Lenscrafters (<https://onesight.org/faqs/>)

Through OneSight's OnSite Voucher Program, eligible patients can receive glasses free of charge. The patient should:

1. Have their visual and financial need verified by a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization (such as a school, church, Lions Club, Prevent Blindness, Red Cross, or United Way).
2. Obtain a referral letter from the nonprofit (letter should be on company letterhead and include the Tax ID# for the nonprofit).
3. Take the referral letter issued by the nonprofit as well as a valid prescription to a participating Luxottica Retail Location ([LensCrafters](#), [Target Optical](#), [Sears Optical](#) or [Pearle Vision](#) corporate store) to receive a pair of glasses at no charge.
4. If the patient does not already have a valid prescription (one that is less than 2 years old) he or she can ask if the onsite doctor at the optical retailer is able to donate an eye exam or they can reach out to [Prevent Blindness](#) for assistance.

ReSpectacle (<https://respectacle.org/search>)

- These glasses can currently be ordered online by any person who knows their prescription and the cost is a \$5.00 processing fee.

- These glasses start at about \$12.00 for just frames with a basic prescription and shipping. Costs vary with prescription type.
