RE: Parking

MCWAH recognizes that parking is an important issue to incoming residents. Below is information concerning parking passes at some of the affiliated hospitals. If you are in the Milwaukee area prior to June 30th, you may wish to obtain your Veterans Affairs parking card before you are scheduled to work. Residents that will be rotating at Children's Wisconsin (CW) are encouraged to come to the Provider Support Service department at CW the week prior to their rotation to get their ID badges.

Froedtert Memorial Lutheran Hospital: Prior to obtaining your Froedtert badge, you must first obtain your MCW ID badge. For information on the MCW ID badge, please refer to the May benefit letter that was emailed to you (and is also on our website). To obtain a Froedtert parking pass, you must first go to the office labeled "Staff ID Badges" on the 1st floor, in the West Hospital across from the B elevators to obtain a Froedtert ID Badge. The office is open from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. You may obtain your badge beginning June 19, 2025. Next you need to go to the Parking Office located on level G, north side of Specialty Clinics (orange structure). Please park in a designated parking spot. Do not park parallel in front of the Parking Office. Bring your Froedtert ID badge and the application form with you. You must present this form in person. The Parking Office is open from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Please note that your Froedtert ID also gives you access to the resident call rooms at FMLH and allows you to receive a 10% discount in the FMLH cafeteria. All housestaff will be given access to Specialty Clinics (orange structure). You must park on Level 3 at all times when on Froedtert campus.

Children's Wisconsin: The Provider Support team facilitate your access at Children's Wisconsin, including your Children's ID badge and Children's network login, which is also used for Epic access. Provider Support partners with your program coordinator regarding this access. Your program coordinator will reach out to you prior to the start of your rotation with specific directions on how to obtain your badge and login information. Parking is available in the North parking structure off Watertown Plank Road and should only be used during your rotation at Children's Wisconsin.

Veteran's Affairs Medical Center: Parking is available to the housestaff in the gated North parking lots 11, 12 and 13 (accessible from N. Washington Drive). You will need a VA ID badge to access the gated lot, and obtain a red parking decal for your vehicle from the PIV Office located in room 70-E-41, in Building 70 connected to the main hospital (Building 111). The PIV office is open Monday – Friday 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. In addition to these spaces, there is parking in the non-gated overflow lot at Building 6, with continuous shuttles between it and the main hospital. Housestaff may request an escort to their vehicle late at night from the Police Service Office located at the East entrance of the hospital. **Patient and Visitor Parking** is located east of the hospital (Building 111) near the East Entrance in parking areas 2, 4, 5. **This area is reserved Monday thru Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. for patient and visitor parking only**. All other times, these areas are open to all employees; however, employee's vehicle must be removed from parking areas 2, 4, 5 prior to 8:00 a.m. Monday thru Friday.
