Required Courses for Incoming Housestaff

Each year MCWAH requires incoming housestaff to complete certain mandatory courses. Please review the information below and **complete all requirements by June 30, 2025.** The courses are found on two separate platforms: Desire2Learn (D2L) and Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI)

I. Desire2Learn (D2L) Courses

The following mandatory Courses and Orientation Modules are located on the MCW learning management system, Desire2Learn (D2L), and **must be completed by June 30, 2025.** All D2L Coursework will be available for completion on May 15, 2025.

In order to receive credit for each module you must complete a quiz with a score of 70% or better. Completion of these modules will be tracked by MCWAH.

II. Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI) Open School Courses

You are also required to complete several IHI Open School modules. **To receive credit**, you must successfully complete each lesson and the associated post-test for each module **by the due dates noted below.** If you have already completed all or some of these courses at a previous institution, you may also provide <u>completion certificates</u> via email to lan Worcester (<u>iworcester@mcw.edu</u>) in the GME office to receive credit.

IHI Account Setup and Course Enrollment

To take IHI Open School Modules, you will need to <u>create or update your existing account</u> on IHI Open School with your mcw.edu email address. When filling out contact information, select 'Medical College of Wisconsin Affiliated Hospitals Inc. - - Milwaukee, WI' as your Organization. When completing demographic information be sure set your Work Role to 'Resident/Intern' (there is no 'Fellow' option) in the demographics tab.

- After you have created an account <u>USE THIS LINK TO LOG IN TO IHI OPEN SCHOOL</u>, once logged in click on the box that says "Browse Catalog".
- Enter the IHI Access Code at the top of the catalog: **90573**
- Locate the IHI modules listed below by searching for them in the catalog.
- Click the "Enroll" button to enroll and click the "Launch" button to complete your course. If you see "Add to Cart" instead of "Enroll", ensure you have entered the IHI Access Code

The following IHI Modules must be completed by June 30, 2025:

PS 101: Introduction to Patient Safety (estimated completion time (ECT) 75 Minutes)

- PS 102: From Error to Harm (ECT 75 Minutes)
- PS 103: Human Factors and Safety (ECT 75 Minutes)
- PS 105: Responding to Adverse Events (ECT 75 Minutes)
- PS 201: Root Cause Analyses and Actions (ECT 75 Minutes)
- QI 101: Introduction to Health Care Improvement (ECT 75 Minutes)
- QI 102: How to Improve with the Model for Improvement (ECT 90 Minutes)

The estimated time to complete each IHI module is noted above. MCWAH's 6 required learning modules are estimated to take ~7.5 hours to complete. MCWAH's realtime orientation will take place on Friday June 28, 2025, and is anticipated to run from 8:30AM – 12:00PM leaving housestaff several hours to complete any unfinished MCWAH requirements on that day. Please plan accordingly to ensure all requirements are complete by the end of the day on June 30, 2025.
