

Required Courses for Incoming Housestaff

Each year MCWAH requires incoming housestaff to complete certain mandatory courses. Please review the information below and **complete all requirements by the dates noted.**

I. Desire2Learn (D2L) Courses


The following mandatory courses are located on the MCW learning management system, Desire2Learn (D2L), and **must be completed by June 30, 2021. In order to receive credit for each module you must complete a quiz with a score of 70% or better. Completion of these modules will be tracked by MCWAH.**

1. AIDET®
2. Residents and Fellows as Educators
3. Sleep-related Fatigue
4. Substance Abuse
5. MCWAH Respect Training
6. HIPAA

Click on the 'Faculty, Staff, Learner Login' link. This will take you to the Onelogin interface. From there, use your MCW username (not full email) and password, and respond to a duo challenge if you are off campus. This will pass you into D2L. Once you have logged in you will arrive at the course landing page where you will see a Content Browser containing each individual course module, as well as the grouping of orientation presentations.

III. Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI) Open School Modules

You are also required to complete several IHI Open School modules. **To receive credit**, you must successfully complete each lesson and the associated post-test for each module and **provide your Program Coordinator with a certificate of completion by the due dates noted below.**

To take IHI Open School Modules, you will need to [create or update your existing account](#) on IHI Open School with your mcw.edu email address. When filling out contact information be sure to select 'Medical College of Wisconsin Affiliated Hospitals - Milwaukee, WI' as your Organization. When completing demographic information be sure set your 'Primary Role' to 'Resident/Intern' (there is no 'Fellow' option) in the demographics tab so that you can access courses.

After you have created an account [USE THIS LINK TO LOG IN TO IHI OPEN SCHOOL](#), once logged in you will see "Welcome to IHI Learning and Education" click on the box that says "Browse Catalog" and use the search field to locate the required modules, click on "Enroll," then select the module from your Learning Center that you want to complete and click "Launch" to begin the course.

PS 101: Introduction to Patient Safety (estimated completion time (ECT) 75 Minutes)

PS 102: From Error to Harm (ECT 75 Minutes)

PS 202: Achieving Total Systems Safety (ECT 75 Minutes)

TA 102: Improving Health Equity (ECT 90 Minutes)

The IHI Modules noted below must be completed before October 1, 2021:

QI 101: Introduction to Health Care Improvement (ECT 75 Minutes)

QI 102: How to Improve with the Model for Improvement (ECT 90 Minutes)

PS 105: Responding to Adverse Events (ECT 75 Minutes)

Once you have successfully completed each lesson and the associated post-test be sure to claim credit and create a certificate of completion to provide to your Program Coordinator as evidence of completion. **Instructions that show how to claim credit and print a certificate of completion** can be found [here](#) (please note that if you scroll down to item #8, you will be directed to your own individual certificate center).
