*Specific numbers of each type of rotation will vary depending on the individual resident's requests, needs, and career goals. Scheduling is meant to be flexible to allow tailoring to the individual resident while still meeting ACGME and ABIM requirements. Preliminary interns have 6-7 months total of inpatient wards and categorical PG-1's have 7-8 months total of inpatient wards. Categorical PG-2's and PG-3's have 5-6 months of wards total. Primary care PG-1's have 6-7 months of wards, PG-2's and PG-3's 4-5 months total of ward rotations. Note also that many ward rotations do not have call.
