

Research participants are needed for Functional Magnetic Resonance Imaging (fMRI) studies of Attention!

Researchers at the Medical College of Wisconsin are seeking Healthy Adults to participate in a study, looking at changes that occur in **ATTENTION** across the lifespan.

The study is open to healthy adults, ages **60-80**, who are native English speakers with intact speech perception, and without known hearing loss, cognitive impairment, attention deficit, or neurological/psychiatric disorders.

The studies are conducted at the Medical College during the day and evenings. The fMRI scan does not involve radiation or injected dyes. The study requires two sessions, each lasting one to three hours. A stipend (10/h session 1, 12/h session 2) will be paid for participation in the study.
