The program is designed to expose students to the outstanding training programs at MCW, connect students to current MCW faculty, students, and trainees, and cultural inclusion and professional identity development opportunities. Students will have opportunities for mentoring and advising from URiM faculty and trainees. Dedicated social engagement through activities showcasing the city of Milwaukee will also be provided.

Program Details

- MCW accepts applications through the [VSLO \(Visiting Student Learning Opportunities\)](#) for full-time senior medical students attending an LCME-accredited medical school or COCA-accredited osteopathic medical school seeking to take an MCW 4-week elective for credit during the fall term only (July - December). Rotation dates are established by MCW and noted on the [VSLO MCW Information Page](#) (enter Medical College of Wisconsin as the institution). - Accepted students must be:
 - In good standing at their home institutions
 - Has demonstrated record of academic excellence
 - Attending a LCME accredited medical school
 - Current 4th year Medical School student who is from or have lived experience engaging people in underserved communities in the United States
- Accepted students will receive a travel stipend up to \$2,000 to cover application costs, housing, transportation, and other living expenses.
- Students may attend resident didactics, MCW conferences and development sessions (as applicable).

Available Rotations

All visiting student electives are available for participation. Applications will be accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis, by an established committee, beginning April 1, 2023.
