
















Program Structure








PGY-2:

 - Head and neck surgeries, neck dissections







PGY-3:

Call Schedule

- Home call
- Hospitals covered:
 - Froedtert Hospital
 - Children's Wisconsin
 - VA
- Facial trauma call, every other week
- Aerodigestive foreign body call, every other week
 - Alternates with facial trauma
- Meal cards provided





Call Schedule

- PGY-1
 - Buddy call 1-2 weekends per month while on ENT service
 - No overnight call (just 7am-7pm)
 - Off service --> night float
 - No call on Anesthesia, Plastic Surgery, or General Surgery
- PGY-2 through PGY-4*
 - ~ 2-3 weeknight calls/month
 - ~ 1 weekend/month (Friday/Sunday or Saturday)
- PGY-5/Childrens Chief (PGY-4)
 - Second call for Froedtert and the VA
 - No Children's call




















Starting salaries for the 2022-2023 academic year:
