# General & Community Pediatrics Division Chief



**The Department of Pediatrics at the Medical College of Wisconsin is seeking a full time Division Chief for General and Community Pediatrics. A strong scholarly background and a passion for medical education, community pediatrics and clinical care will characterize the ideal leader for this position. The initial charge for this enterprise leader will be to build a division mindful of its primary missions of scholarship, medical education, community pediatrics and patient care.**

### **JOB DESCRIPTION**

This position, the Division Chief of General and Community Pediatrics at MCW, requires someone who excels in a highly visible leadership position. It is anticipated that this individual will serve as a leader within the Department of Pediatrics medical education infrastructure based on accompanying skill sets and experience. This enterprise leader will also serve as a key intersection with the Children's Medical Group. The Children's Medical Group (CMG) is a branch of the Children's Hospital Healthcare System that serves as the primary medical home for >140,000 children in Wisconsin. CMG involves 26 locations and 146 providers, including Midtown in central city Milwaukee. Midtown functions as the academic center for general pediatrics within the Pediatric enterprise.

Ideal qualifications for this candidate include a M.D. or D.O, successful completion of an approved pediatric residency training program, board certification in Pediatrics, eligibility for a Wisconsin Medical License, 5 years of experience in academic pediatrics and the ability to foster collegiality and work collaboratively in a matrixed diverse environment. Further qualifications that will poise the candidate for favorable consideration include successful completion of a general pediatric fellowship and / or successful completion of a master's in medical education.

The individual selected for this position will be an enthusiastic, energetic and high eIQ leader. Responsibilities for the position include successfully executing a vision for programmatic excellence and growth in all the pediatric enterprise's missions (clinical care, education, research, community service) while responsibly administrating the division's finances.

As Division Chief of General and Community Pediatrics, this individual will report to the Chair of Pediatrics.



## **MEDICAL COLLEGE OF WISCONSIN | MCW.EDU**

MCW offers medical, master's, doctorates, master of public health and master of art degrees. MCW has approximately 1,600 full-time and part-time faculty and approximately 3,445 full-time employees, making it one of the largest health care employers in Wisconsin. MCW works with national and international medical specialty societies and community hospitals to accredit approximately 200 continuing medical education activities annually for physicians and other health professionals.

## **CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF WISCONSIN | CHW.ORG**

A 306-bed freestanding hospital dedicated solely to the care of children, Children's is one of the top ranked pediatric hospitals in the country. It offers a Level I Trauma Center, a Level I surgery center, a Level IV neonatal intensive care unit and a 72-bed pediatric intensive care unit. It is the primary pediatric hospital for all of the children of Southeast Wisconsin and the main referral center for children living in much of Wisconsin and northern Illinois. The hospital also receives patients from across the country and around the world for specific subspecialty care.

## **CHILDREN'S MEDICAL GROUP**

Children's Medical Group (CMG) provides primary care for > 140,000 children. CMG has 146 providers in 26 locations, including six locations in central city Milwaukee. CMG's Midtown Pediatrics is the academic center for general pediatrics for our enterprise. Since 2014 there has been a 12% growth in paneled patients. Children's Medical Group (CMG) is the primary care division of Children's Hospital of Wisconsin and has strong ties with MCW. Most of the CMG pediatricians are volunteer teaching faculty and provide outpatient experience for pediatric residents in their clinics. CMG's clinics have been recognized as Patient Centered Medical Homes. The clinics provide high quality care as measured by the rates of developmental screening (80%), use of asthma control testing (ACT rates 93%), adolescent screening rates for depression (PHQ-9 96%) and follow-up care for ADHD (80%). These measures far exceed published national rates. The infrastructure and processes supporting these measures represent strong collaboration between CMG and MCW specialty providers and have been presented at the local, state and national level. CMG providers collaborate individually and collectively with MCW clinical researchers in grant funded projects.
