CLINIC GOALS

To provide convenient, comprehensive, health care to teenage mothers and their children.

To foster a more positive future for the mother and child by preventing repeat teen pregnancy and promoting high school graduation.

APPOINTMENTS ARE SCHEDULED:

Once a month: first 6 months of the baby's life.

Every Other Month: 6 to 12 months old.

Every 3 months: 1 to 2 years old.

Every 6 months: until mother graduates from high school or turns 21 years old.

The teen mother and her baby are seen at the **same time** by the **same doctor or nurse practitioner** during their visit.
