One out of five women will experience maternal mental health condition yet 75% of women will not receive treatment. Perinatal mental health conditions are a leading a preventable cause of maternal mortality. Those with a history of adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) and exposure to chronic stressors such a poverty, racism, or discrimination are more likely to develop a mental health condition yet are less likely to be screened or adequately treated, exacerbating health inequities.
