Radiation Dose During Pregnancy

Purpose: To provide an evaluation of working conditions and provide monitoring, as necessary, of the declared pregnant workers

Definition: Declared Pregnant Worker – a person who has voluntarily informed MCW Radiation Safety of a pregnancy and the estimated date of conception

Policy:

- 1. A declaration of pregnancy must be in writing and submitted to the Radiation Safety Office. Contact Radiation Safety for a form that may be completed to declare a pregnancy.
- 2. Prenatal radiation dose information shall be provided with the Declared Pregnant Worker application from Radiation Safety.
- 3. Radiation Safety will evaluate the declared pregnant worker's working conditions and determine if any restrictions or modifications to the work environment are needed.
- 4. Once a person declares themselves as a pregnant worker, the radiation dose limits will be reduced to 0.5 rem for the pregnancy.
- 5. A second radiation dosimeter may be issued by Radiation Safety. This second dosimeter is intended to be worn at the abdominal level, under any worn lead shielding.
- 6. A pregnancy may be undeclared, which must be in writing. Contact Radiation Safety for a form that be completed to undeclare a pregnancy.
