Academic Enrichment Electives for M1-2s Overview

- 1. Academic Enrichment Electives (AEE's) will be offered to students in the M1 andM2 years to complement and expand on MCW Global Competencies and provide alignment with LCME emphasis areas.
- 2. Students may opt to enroll (as space is available) as they would in any required course. There is no minimum or maximum number of elective requirements during the M1-2 years.
- 3. An AAE must be offered/directed by MCW Faculty.
- 4. An AAE can be dropped prior to the 3rd session/activity of the elective and will not appear on the transcript. If dropped after this window, a withdrawal will be recorded for the elective.
- 5. AEEs will be graded as Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory and appear on the transcript under Academic Enrichment.
- 6. The M1-2 Subcommittee will review and approve AEEs using the following criteria:
 - a) Contribution of the AAE to MD degree as judged by alignment with MCW Global Competencies and the LCME emphasis areas (relevance).
 - b) Educational and academic rigor of the AEE:
 - 1. Clear objectives aligned with MCW Global Competencies.
 - 2. Structured curriculum with teaching methods congruent with objectives and described using AAMC MedBiquitous terms.
 - 3. Clear learner assessment criteria described using AAMC MedBiquitous terms.
 - c) Evaluation of the AAE by students
- 7. At the end of each AAE, students will evaluate these electives using the same course evaluation methods used for all required courses. The M1-2 Subcommittee will review all course evaluations of these electives using the same process established for required courses.

The above information should be entered into the <u>New Course Proposal Form</u> and submitted to the CEC.
