

Does the Miller High Life Theatre accommodate ADA seating?

Yes, there are 92 ADA seats available at the theatre. Upon arrival, please see a Miller High Life Theatre usher to escort guests to appropriate seating.

Do I need tickets for my guests attending the Hooding and Commencement Ceremonies?

No – both the Hooding and Commencement Ceremonies are a first-come, first-serve basis and no tickets are required. The Theatre seats just over 4,000.

Does my hooder need to wear academic regalia to the Hooding Ceremony?

Hooders are asked to wear professional business attire. Academic regalia is only worn by the graduating students being hooded.

Who can I select to be my hooder?

Any individual that holds either an MD or DO degree. Other degrees are not allowed. Most students will select a family member, friend or mentor. If a special hooder is not provided, a default hooder will be selected for you.

Who can I invite to Senior Dinner?

Invite spouses, partners, parents, grandparents, aunts/uncles, friends, etc. We strongly recommend young children do not attend, as this is intended to be an adult-only event. The dinner is an opportunity for our students to enjoy a convivial evening with their peers, family and friends. The venue advises us they do not cater for or take any responsibility for children at these events, including booster seats and high chairs. MCW will cover the cost for each student plus one guest. Additional guests are welcome for an additional cost.

How are table assignments decided at Senior Dinner?

The table occupancy max at 10 people per table. Where possible, parties with over 10 guests will be sat at adjacent tables and on rare occasions, parties with five or more guests may be separated and seated at adjacent tables. While students can make special requests to be sat with or near classmates, we cannot guarantee that any such request will be accommodated.

What if I and/or my guests have specific religious dietary requirements, e.g. kosher meal?

You are certainly allowed to bring in your own kosher meal as appropriate to your faith. The venue can provide a kosher meal for the same cost as the other entrees, or the guests can bring their meal at their own expense. Please note: these are **RSVP only** events - **absolutely no walk-ins**.

Cancellations must be received by Thursday, April 18, for refunds. Any cancellations made thereafter will not be refunded.

Alcohol is not served with the meal; however, there is a cash bar where beverages can be purchased before and during the event.
