Genetic Counseling (MS) tuition is \$37,510 for the year and student fee of \$550.

Precision Medicine (MS) tuition is \$34,680 for the year.

(e) Coursework in the Clinical and Translational Sciences or Healthcare Technologies Management may have a longer summer budget if taking courses that begin in May.

(f) Includes \$150 student service fee for full-time students. If you are not a full-time student fees will be adjusted accordingly.
