Masters of Medical Physiology (MMP) flat rate tuition \$48,554. Follow 18-week budget for remaining budget categories.

Masters of Genetic Counseling flat rate tuition \$38,822 plus student fee of \$600. Follow 16-week budget for remaining budget categories.
