

Regional Variation Across the United States in Resident Self-Assessment as Compared to their Peers using ACGME Competencies

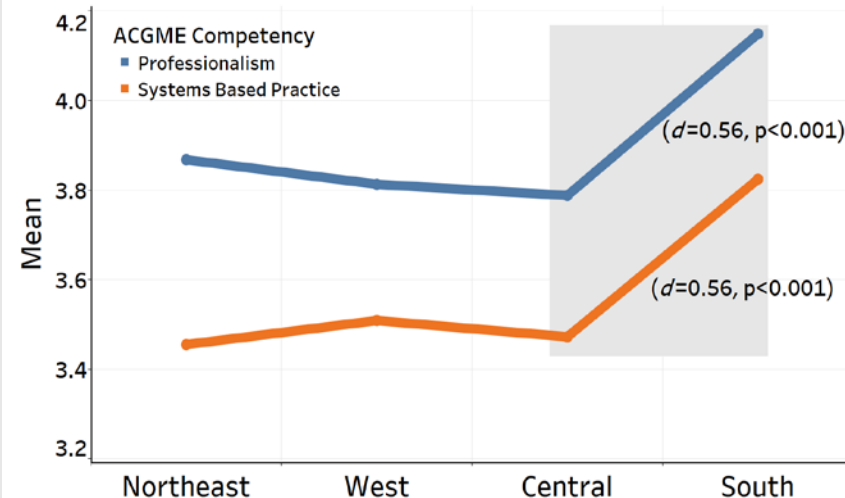

PURPOSE

- Analyze first-year medical residents performance compared to their peers
- Self-assessed based on five ACGME competencies
- Separated by AAMC-defined regions

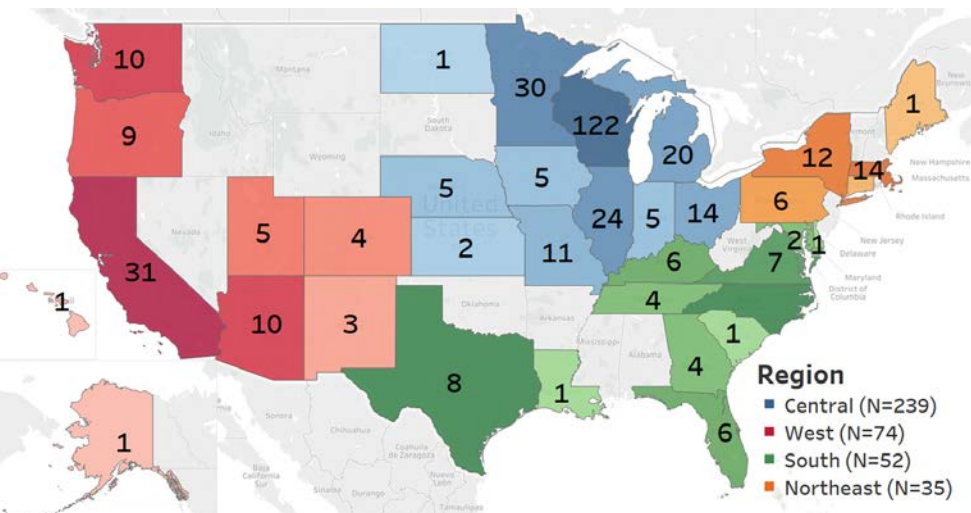
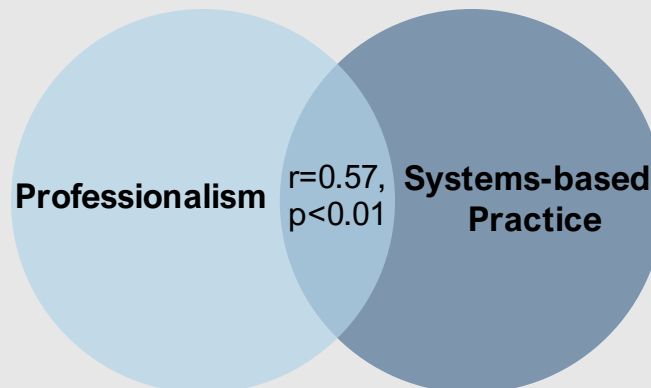
RESULTS

- Graduates reported significantly ($p < 0.05$) different responses between regions in **professionalism** ($\alpha = 0.96$) and **systems-based practice** ($\alpha = 0.93$).



CONCLUSION

- Graduates completing residency in the South rated themselves significantly higher in the areas of professionalism and systems-based practice than those in the Central region.
