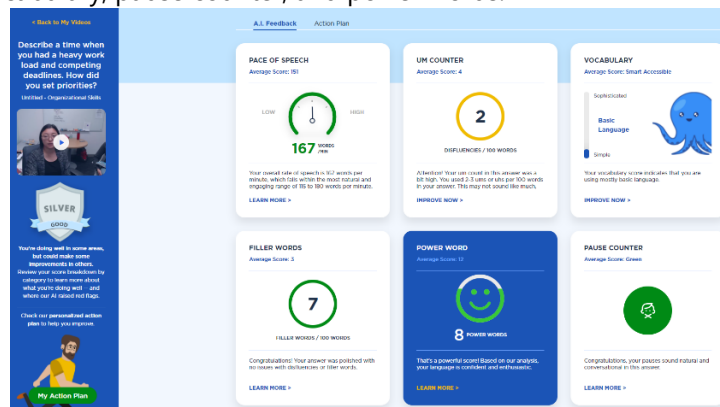

November 8th: Dermatology round 1

November 12th: Plastic Surgery

November 15th: Orthopedics

November 19th: OB/GYN final status released to applicants

November 29th: Dermatology round 2
