Qualtrics Authenticated User Support

After logging into Qualtrics, access support by clicking on the **Help Tab** Choose the **Support Site Button**

Course Import/Export

• To simplify user access to import/export logs, the Course Import/Export tool now includes import/export logs as part of the Course Import/Export History, which include navigation breadcrumbs. In addition, the logs display the results in the order of import/export operations. Previously, import/export logs opened in a new tab and displayed the results out of order, without navigation breadcrumbs.

• As described in the **Discussions** - **New Discussion Evaluation Experience** | **Updated** feature released in <u>December 2021/20.21.12</u>, this feature removes the **d2l.Tools.Activities.CEDiscussionOptIn** configuration variable. This means that administrators can no longer override the variable to opt-out of the new Discussions Evaluation experience.
