The Medical College of Wisconsin is a private, independent school for the health sciences. Founded in 1893 as the Wisconsin College of Physicians and Surgeons, it merged in 1913 with the Milwaukee Medical College to become the Marquette University School of Medicine. In 1967 it separated from Marquette University, and in 1970 changed its name to the Medical College of Wisconsin.

**Accreditation:** The Medical College of Wisconsin is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), as well as the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME). The School of Pharmacy has been granted Candidate status by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE).
