Our online Master of Public Health program is designed to prepare individuals with the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively address public and community health issues. Graduates of the program will be prepared to work in leadership positions in a variety of settings, including but not limited to:

- Non-profit organizations
- Hospitals and healthcare systems
- Community-based organizations
- Academic institutions

Consisting of 42 credits, the curriculum of our MPH program is delivered completely online allowing working professionals the flexibility to fulfill their educational goals. The program uses innovative technologies and applied learning opportunities, and can be completed in two to five years, depending on enrollment status.


## Program Overview

Our MPH program will reinforce the foundational CEPH competencies as well as provide education and training related to the MPH public health practice competencies through asynchronous learning opportunities. The interdisciplinary curriculum has a concentration in public health practice and includes coursework in public health theory and practice, epidemiology, public health data analytics, public health administration, racial

and ethnic inequalities, leadership, community health assessment and improvement, program planning, program evaluation, public health policy, health communication, health promotion and disease prevention, population health management, infectious diseases, and public health law and ethics. The program also incorporates an applied practice experience and an integrative learning experience.

## Admissions



The Master of Public Health program is an online, graduate program designed to meet the needs of individuals who hold at least a bachelor's degree and are interested in public health. Courses are offered through a web-based learning management system and can be taken on a full-time or part-time basis. Both
