As a preceptor, you would provide opportunities for students to practice history and basic exam skills during their clinical experiences. All volunteers will receive an Volunteer Assistant Clinical Professor appointment at the Medical College of Wisconsin.

TIME COMMITMENT

This is a one-year volunteer commitment that runs August - May. Preceptors are encouraged to participate annually.
