

GLOBAL HEALTH PATHWAY - CORE COMPETENCIES

1. Medical Knowledge: Acquire and apply medical knowledge specific to global health issues in order to expand understanding of unique problems. Expand awareness of a specific global health issue and country which is of particular personal interest.
2. Practice-based learning: Gain ability to investigate specific global health issues from local, foreign and international data sets and apply this information to specific global health issues.
3. Interpersonal Communication: Strengthen communication skills when dealing with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) and deaf patients.
4. Expand Awareness: Learn about a specific global health issue and/or country of particular interest.
5. Professionalism: Learn professional behavior and interpersonal interactions that are appropriate for specific global cultural contexts.
6. Systems-based practice: Understand the complexity of global health studies in terms of application of ethical human study regulations.
