Do you look for a specific Step 1 score?

No, we do not look for a specific Step 1 score. We look for well-rounded applicants.

Do you require Step 2 exam prior to interviewing?

No, we do not require Step 2 to be taken prior to interviewing.

We encourage research, but it is not necessary for the specialty.

Do you recommend more than one rotation in the chosen specialty?

We recommend clerkships, as per medical school curriculum in Internal Medicine and Pediatrics.

If the applicant is from MCW, do you recommend an away rotation?

Typically, we do not recommend an away rotation. If a student is interested in another health care system, they can take an away rotation.
