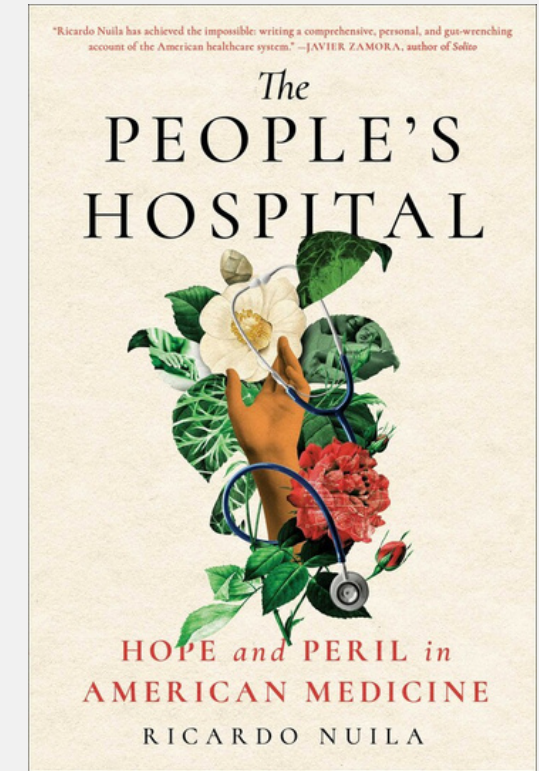




# Fireside Chat with Dr. Ricardo Nuila

All are invited to attend a fireside chat with Dr. Ricardo Nuila, renowned physician and author of *The People's Hospital: Hope and Peril in American Medicine*.

Dr. Ricardo Nuila is a writer, teacher, and practicing internal medicine physician. He is an associate professor of medicine, medical ethics, and health policy at the Baylor College of Medicine, where he directs the Humanities Expression and Arts Lab [HEAL] program. His stunning debut, *The People's Hospital: Hope and Peril in American Medicine*, which details the stories of five Houstonians unable to access healthcare in his hometown of Houston, TX, was selected as a semi-finalist for the Carnegie Medal for Excellence in Nonfiction and named one of the Best Books of 2023 by Amazon, the Kirkus Review, and the Washington Post.
