POLICY: Moonlighting

Programs must comply with the MCWAH Moonlight policy. Should there be a conflict with the MCWAH policy and the program information outlined below, MCWAH's policy takes precedence.

ACGME Medical Genetics Program Requirements state:

- 1. Moonlighting must not interfere with the ability of the resident to achieve the goals and objectives of the educational program.
- 2. Time spent by residents in Internal and External Moonlighting (as defined in the ACGME Glossary of Terms) must be counted towards the 80-hour Maximum Weekly Hour Limit.
- 3. PGY-1 residents are not permitted to moonlight.

The Program Director of the Medical Genetics Residency Program prefers no moonlighting during the 2 year program. Moonlighting would interfere with required reading and call schedules.
