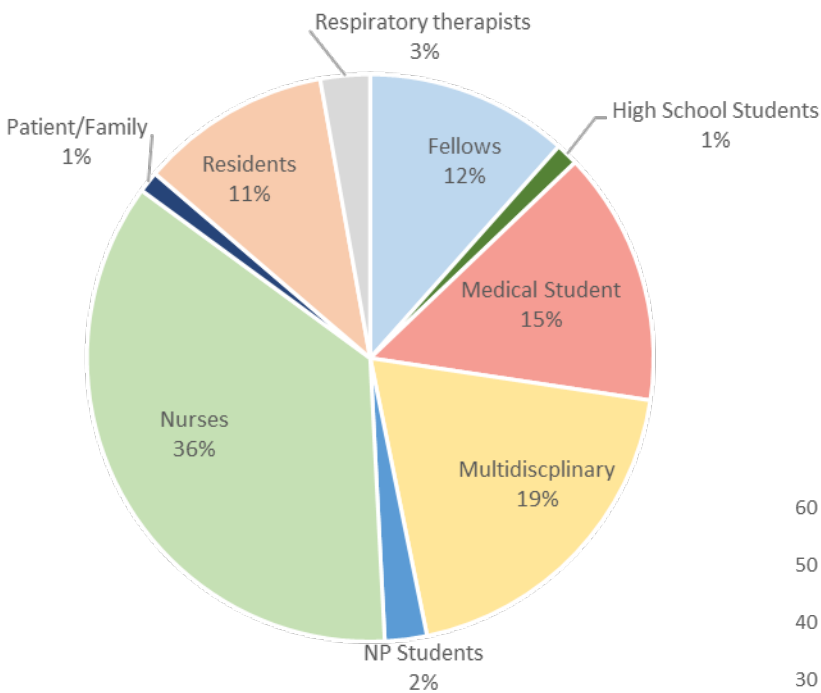

## Participants



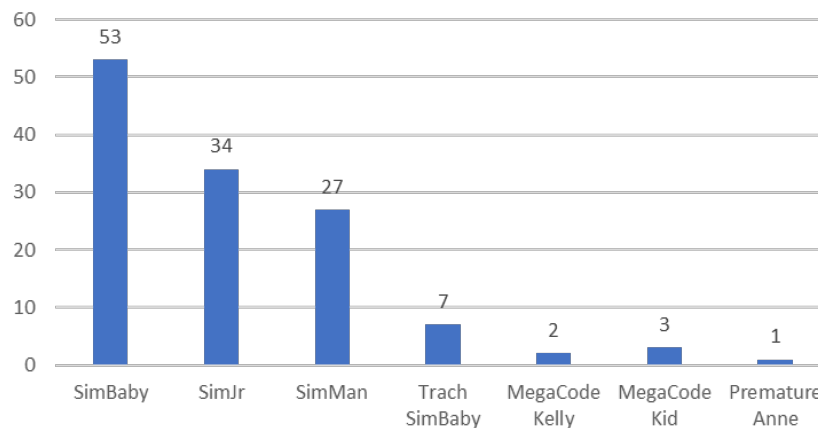

## Manikins Used



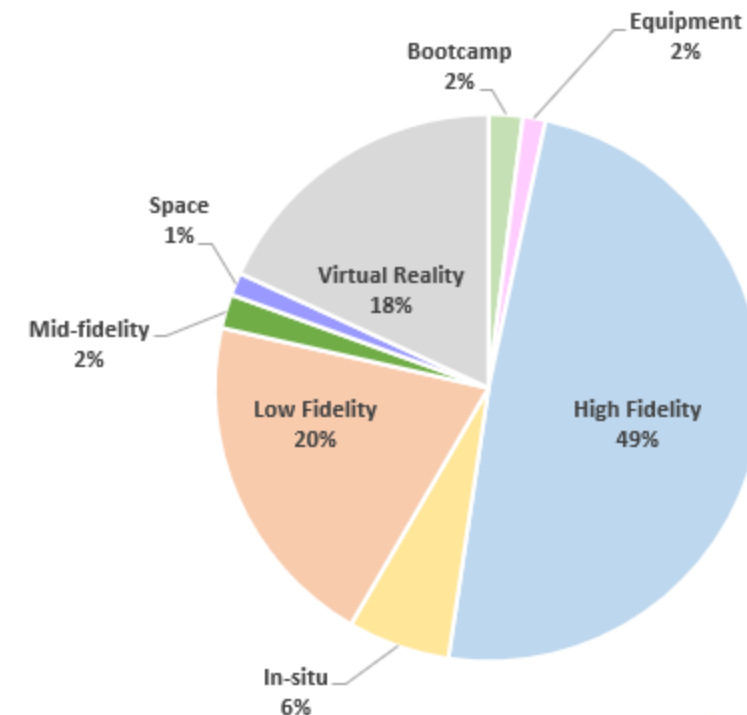

- Low-Fidelity/task trainer events use task trainers, skills stations, and/or role play.
