The Medical College of Wisconsin is a private, independent school for the health sciences comprised of the School of Graduate Studies, the School of Medicine and the School of Pharmacy. Founded in 1893 as the Wisconsin College of Physicians and Surgeons, it merged in 1913 with the Milwaukee Medical College to become the Marquette University School of Medicine. In 1967 it separated from Marquette University, and in 1970 changed its name to the Medical College of Wisconsin. The Medical School established a campus in Green Bay, Wisconsin in 2015 and a campus in Wausau, Wisconsin in 2016.

Accreditation: The Medical College of Wisconsin is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). The Doctor of Medicine program is accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME). The Doctor of Pharmacy program is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE).

Official Transcript: The official transcript is a document printed on security paper, bearing the signature of the university registrar, and sent directly from the Medical College of Wisconsin to the recipient. The message "ISSUED TO STUDENT" appears on the transcript when the transcript is provided directly to the student. The official transcript includes all academic work at the Medical College of Wisconsin whether passed, failed, remediated or repeated.
